Dear Parent/Guardian of Students at Roland School,

Roland School and Prairie Rose School Division have been investigating and working closely with Manitoba Education and Manitoba public health officials over the last few days. Absences due to COVID like illness continue to be over 30% at Roland School. Out of an abundance of precaution, and for the safety of students and staff, Roland School will be moving to remote learning for 14 days, starting May 8th and ending May 25th, 2021.

Roland School will continue working closely with public health officials during the 14 days of remote learning, and following their recommendations.

As advised by Public Health, if students and/or staff develop a new onset or worsening of any one symptom listed in Column A, or any two or more symptoms listed in Column B (see table below), even if mild, school officials require that they stay home for 10 days. The symptomatic student or staff should seek testing. Household members without symptoms are to self-isolate (quarantine) until the sick individual's test result is received.
